As individuals, we set aside savings for the emergencies we cannot yet see.

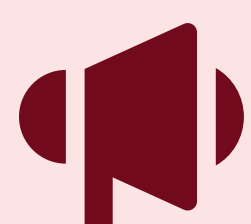
Humanity needs the same foresight.

Optimizing aid spending

We make small yearly grants to ensure we're ready when the time comes to make a big one. In 2025, we granted £4,000 (\$5,393) to METR, a research nonprofit building the evaluations that measure how capable advanced AI systems are becoming.

METR develops autonomous capability evaluations for frontier AI and tracks how quickly those capabilities are doubling over time. Capability doubling times can inform AI timelines, and therefore the timing of our own grantmaking.

Our grant supports METR's research and its wider dissemination, helping critical decisions about AI safety and preparedness reach the people who need them.

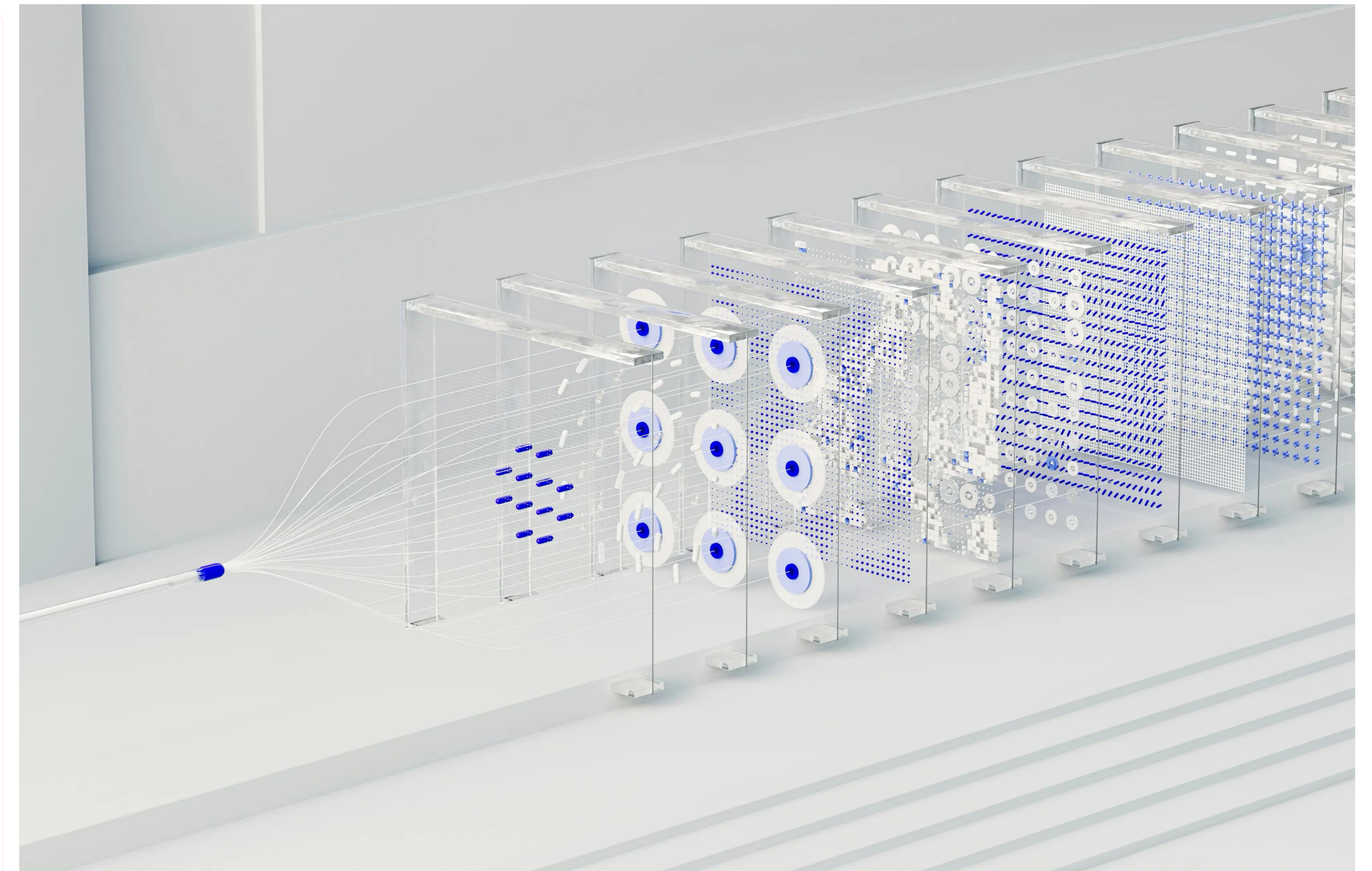

We invest your contributions so they keep collecting interest until the time comes to use them.

Every contribution is pooled and invested for long-term growth in a low-fee global stock index fund. As the Fund compounds, our capacity to do good grows with it, and the capital stays ready to deploy the moment a rare opportunity or catastrophic crisis demands it.

Historically, money in the global stock market has roughly doubled every decade.* So even with no new contributions, today's Fund could grow many times over in the decades ahead.
